# THE *Gardens*



- the Gardens display the largest collection in the world of Australian plant species
- the collection includes about one third of Australia's known flowering plants — some never cultivated before
- the plant collection is a genetic 'safe-deposit box' for the many species threatened in their natural environment
- the Gardens and the Herbarium are an invaluable resource for plant research
- visitors from around the world enjoy the beauty and great diversity within the collection
- children are given the opportunity to learn about the plants, birds, animals and insects that find their homes within the Gardens



# THE *Fund*
