

Lighting of the Rainforest Gully

A lighting system in the Rainforest Gully was installed in early 2012. The first public event featuring the display was an exclusive night adventure during Canberra's *Enlighten Festival* in early March that year.

This was a joint Friends and Gardens project - the Friends provided \$30,000.

The lighting system consists of 125 LED spotlights illuminating selected trees, boardwalk markers and a lighted handrail. The display allows visitors to immerse themselves in a unique after-dark experience of the Gully's rich diversity of plants.

Tours of the illuminated Rainforest Gully are available to school groups, tour groups and the general public during special events.
