Presentation of prizes will be at 12 noon, Saturday 28 September 2024

(Individual entries accepted)

All entries must be photographs taken within the Australian National Botanic Gardens in Canberra, and feature some aspect of the gardens, such as plants, wildlife, or scenery.

Photographs should not include a person who is recognisable from the image.

CATEGORIES:

- Monochrome
- Colour

Cropping, straightening, exposure adjustment and minor technical adjustments are permitted in all categories.

Each student is allowed one entry per category (a maximum of two entries overall).

CASH PRIZES will be awarded in each category:

- First : \$250
- Second : \$150
- Third : \$100

Certificates may also be presented.

- \$200 will be awarded to the School or College of each First prize
- \$100 will be awarded to the School or College of each Second prize
- \$50 will be awarded to the School or College of each Third prize

Schools with prize winners will also receive celebratory plants.

HOW TO ENTER

Entries must be lodged using the online entry form at <u>www.friendsanbg.org.au/schoolscomp2024</u>, which will be available only during the competition period between 1 July and 30 August 2024.

Closing date for entries: Photographs must be received before 5pm Friday 30 August 2024.

Prizes will be presented: at 12 noon, Saturday 28 September, at the Gardens.

Selected photographs will be exhibited at A3 size.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entrants must complete the online entry form, providing the following information:

- Their name
- Their year in school
- An email address (see under 'Privacy' below)
- The name of their school, and an email address and phone number to contact at the school
- A brief title for each photograph entered.

The photographs entered must be uploaded as digital image files via the online form. The files should be in **jpeg** format. They should have sufficient resolution (number of pixels) to present well to the judges and to allow entries to be exhibited at A3 size. The judges will make no concessions for poor quality files.

The competition organisers may limit the maximum size of entries, for example to 3MB, to manage the impact on available IT resources. The maximum size will be announced before entries open on 1 July.

Entries must be received by the competition organisers before 5pm Friday 30 August 2024. The organisers will accept no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries, or entries not received by the organisers for any reason whatsoever.

Entrants will be required to declare that they accept the following conditions:

- a. The original photographs were taken by the entrant at the Australian National Botanic Gardens in Canberra between 30 August 2023 and 30 August 2024
- b. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- c. The Australian National Botanic Gardens and the Friends of the ANBG will have the right to use any submitted photographs in its newsletter, website, display and/or promotional material. All published images will be credited.
- d. The restrictions of the Australian National Botanic Gardens as set out in the Visitor Code were respected.
- e. There are no recognisable people in the photos entered.

Privacy

An email address is required so the competition organisers can contact entrants about their entry if necessary. The email address can belong to a parent, carer or other responsible person. The address will not be used for any other purpose, will be kept confidential, and will not be passed on to anyone who is not involved in running the competition.
